

Tail-Wagging Doggy Ice Cream Recipe

As we gear up for our doggy ice cream social this month, here's a special homemade ice cream treat you can make for your four-legged friends with pumpkin, banana, yogurt and peanut butter.

Ingredients:

- 1 medium ripe banana
- 1/2 cup natural peanut butter
- 32 oz plain Greek yogurt
- 1/4 cup pumpkin puree
- 40 small biscuits

Instructions:

- In a large mixing bowl, beat banana with peanut butter, pumpkin, and yogurt until creamy and combined.
- Using a 1 Tablespoon cookie scoop, spoon mixture into ice cube trays. (about 2/3 full).

- Press one dog treat into each ice cube form, then gently tap the ice cube tray on the counter so the filling comes up around the edges of the treats. You may need to "re-stand" the treats vertically.
- Freeze treats for about 2 hours.
- Dish out those pup-approved frozen delights and be on the lookout for any tails wagging into overdrive!
